Situation	What to do
Student feels sick / shows symptoms	 If symptoms come up at school, parents will be called, and student and siblings will be sent home immediately. All students in the home may return to school if the symptoms disappear within 24 hours and they have not been exposed to any individual infected with COVID-19 If symptoms do not disappear within 24 hours, the individual should visit their healthcare provider for COVID-19 testing (it is important to note the type of test administered) and quarantine with the entire family while awaiting the test result. In this case, documentation of a negative test for COVID-19 and 24-hours with no fever (without fever-reducing medication) is required. Virtual learning goes into effect while at home
Student tests <u>positive</u> for COVID-19	 Principal will send COVID-19 Exposure and Cohort Quarantine letter to community and cohort. Cohort quarantines for 14 days from last contact. Virtual learning goes into effect. Student must complete 10 days isolation from date of first symptom and be fever free for 24 hrs. without fever-reducing meds and other symptoms 75% improved. Dr's note documenting alternative diagnosis or negative COVID-19 test required to return to school.
Student tests negative for COVID-19	 Student must be fever-free for 24 hrs. with no fever-reducing meds and other symptoms 75% improved. Follow healthcare provider directions, recommended treatment and return to school guidance. Dr's note documenting alternative diagnosis or negative COVID-19 test required to return to school
Exposure: Student's household member shows symptoms	 Notify the school immediately The student remains at home until family member gets tested/results. Virtual learning goes into effect. If family member does not test, or tests positive, the student must quarantine for 14 days from the last contact with infected member. If family member has a negative test result, the student returns to school. Dr's note documenting alternative diagnosis or negative COVID-19 test required to return to school
Travel to states <u>on/</u> <u>out</u> Chicago Travel Quarantine List (CTQL)	 Parent monitors health. If a household member travels within the CTQL, student is permitted to return to school, following that: The student remains at home until family member gets tested and results are cleared. Virtual learning goes into effect. If family member does not test, tests positive, or travels to states outside of the CTQL, the student must quarantine for 14 days from the last contact with infected member. If family member has a negative test result, the student returns to school. Dr's note documenting alternative diagnosis or negative COVID-19 test required to return to school
Strong recommendations	 Do the right thing. Take every precaution and follow CDC guidelines; wear masks, physically distance, avoid crowds and large gatherings, and wash hands often More importantly, BE A POSTIVE ROLE MODEL FOR OUR CHILDREN
